FESTIVAL INFO

THE 11TH EDITION OF LIBF RETURNS TO KIRKSTALL ABBEY, AND WE'VE TAKEN OVER THE ENTIRE VENUE, INCLUDING THE CHURCH, COURTYARD AND CLOISTER.

The handy map on the centre pages in this guide will help you find your way around - remember each session last for five hours (except Thursday which is 6 hour long!), so make sure you explore everything the festival has to offer.

All the beers and ciders available at this year's festival are listed alphabetically on the following pages. There's also info on the food stalls and live music / DJ sets throughout the festival.

Last orders are called 30 mins before the end of each session. The breweries will stop taking orders 15 mins before the session end time.

There are plenty of bins on site, please help us to keep the site clean by disposing of your own rubbish. 'Pass outs' will not be available this year. If you choose to leave before your session ends you will not be re-admitted.

A FEW THINGS TO BE AWARE OF:

- Due to the nature of the site, the ground in some areas is quite uneven and there are some small steps – so please watch your step.
- Ramps will be in place across the site to ensure full accessibility.
- Kirkstall Abbey is also a protected monument so even though it might be tempting to live out some heroic, movie scene please don't climb on the monument! Anyone breaking this golden rule will be ejected from the festival site.
- Please do not smoke on site.

FESTIVAL PAYMENT

The festival will operate a contactless payment system and all the breweries and food stalls will be able to accept card payments. No cash payments will be accepted.

Tokens from previous festivals, that you may have in your possession, can still be used as festival currency. However, these cannot be exchanged for cash and no refunds will be given. WaterAid will be happy to accept token donations, and these will be exchanged for the equivalent cash donation by the festival.

BUNDOBUST

BUNDOBUST X LIBF: 10 YEARS ON...

BUNDOBUST AND LEEDS INTERNATIONAL BEER FESTIVAL. SOME THINGS JUST GO TOGETHER. KIND OF LIKE INDIAN STREET FOOD AND CRAFT BEER.

Bundobust was born out of a collaboration between two Bradford boys, Mayur Patel and Marko Husak. In 2013, Mayur asked Marko on Twitter to collaborate on a street food event. Mayur's family own **Prashad** - one of the UK's most highly regarded Indian restaurants - while Marko operated cult craft beer spot, **The Sparrow Bier Café** in Bradford. Bringing together curry and beer the pair set out to update the classic combo, focusing on authentic dishes and boundary-pushing brews.

They hosted a pop up at each other's venues, before setting their sites on the Town Hall.

2013 saw the first Bundobust pop up at **LIBF**. Their red gazebo proudly announced they were **'Opening Soon' in 'LS1'**. The eagle eyed noticed that the second half of the postcode hadn't quite been confirmed yet...

There was one dish on the menu: Chowpatty Beach Pav Bhaji. A spicy potato, cauliflower, and peas bhaji was cooked Juhu Beach-style on a giant tava, served with buttered pav. Two drinks were on offer; Bundobust's first Coriander Pilsner and Saltaire's Stateside IPA.

Things have got a little bigger since that first gazebo in September 2013, with Bundobust opening its first bricks and mortar location in Leeds in July 2014 before adding restaurants in Manchester, Liverpool and, most recently, Birmingham. In 2021 (after one hell of a Covid related delay) Bundo took their love of beer in house, opening Bundobust Brewery on Oxford St in Manchester.

This year Bundobust are celebrating their 10 year anniversary by taking over our new area, The Refectory. They're paying tribute to their first ever pop up with 'Pav Bhaji Live' on timed cook offs throughout the festival. They've brought a menu of festival favourites (including the iconic Vada Pav) alongside a selection of beers from their brewery. Make sure you try Dhoop, their summer wheat beer which has been flying out of the restaurants. Bombay Mix DJs, pani pur with a tequila twist, and Indian inspired slushies will be keeping the tipi dancing all weekend long.

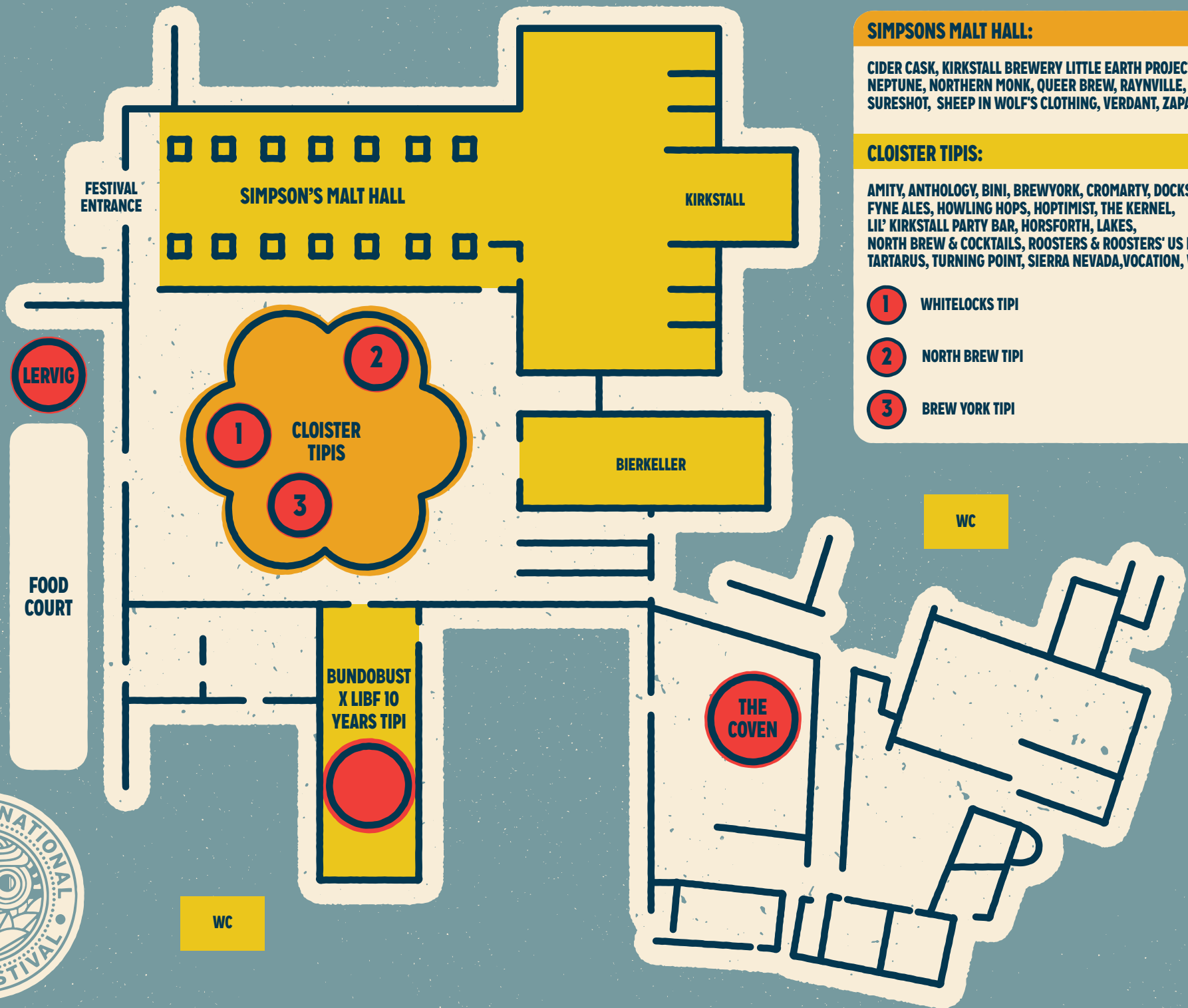
