I have many fond memories of the festival over the years. As a fresh-faced enthusiast, unjaded by the realities of cask washing, the early festivals at Leeds Town Hall proved formative in my appreciation of beer.

In 2018 I was incredibly humbled to receive my first invitation to pour at the festival, sandwiched between The Kernel and Brew By Numbers - two of the early inspirations for starting Anthology. That weekend and throughout the festivals that followed, lasting friendships were formed and I have been lucky enough to share these occasions with those close to me, who have always so generously helped pour (and drink) my beers.

The move to Kirkstall Abbey brought a new monastic shape to the festival. Supping pints in the ancient ruins as the sun sets is quite special, even a hammering of rain can't dampen the spirits. Stunning enough for Turner to paint. Drink in the beauty of the ruins.

Some things I like to do here: Eat a Vada Pav from Bundobust (the secret Laynes croissant edition a few years back being a decadent highlight). Drink a pint of cask beer from the Whitelocks bar. Eat a grilled cheese sandwich from Friends of Ham. Drink something from a brewery you haven't heard of; drink something from the local brewery you know and love. Listen to the bands, the DJs, have a lager in the crypt and sing Somewhere Only We Know on the karaoke. Take some beers home from Johnny, Bal and family at the Raynville stand. Stay hydrated.

Thanks to Maria and Darren as always, and thank you for asking me to write this introduction.

THE 14TH EDITION OF LIBF RETURNS TO KIRKSTALL ABBEY, AND WE'VE TAKEN OVER THE ENTIRE VENUE, INCLUDING THE CHURCH, COURTYARD AND CLOISTER.

The handy map on the centre pages in this guide will help you find your way around - remember each session last for **five hours** (except the **Thursday** session which lasts for **six hours**), so make sure you explore everything the festival has to offer.

Each festival session lasts for 5 hours (except Thursday which lasts 6) with last orders being called 30 mins before the end of each session. The breweries will stop taking orders 15 mins before the session end time.

All the beers and ciders available at this year's festival are listed alphabetically by brewery on the following pages.

Please note: Depending on beer rotation & at the discretion of each brewery, some listed beers may not be available all the time.

There's also info on the food stalls and live music/DJ set performances throughout the festival.

There will also be plenty of bins on site. Please help us to keep the site clean by disposing of your own rubbish.

'Pass outs' will not be available this year. If you choose to leave before your session ends you will not be re-admitted.

A FEW THINGS TO BE AWARE OF:

- Due to the nature of the site, the ground in some areas is quite uneven and there are some small steps - so make sure you watch your step.
- Ramps will be in place across the site to ensure full accessibility.
- Kirkstall Abbey is also a protected monument so please don't climb on any part of the ruins. Anyone breaking this golden rule will be ejected from the festival site.
- There is no smoking or vaping on site.

FESTIVAL PAYMENT

The festival will operate a contactless payment system and all the breweries and food stalls will be able to accept card payments. **No cash payments will be accepted.**

Tokens from previous festivals that you may still have in your possession, will no longer be accepted as payment.

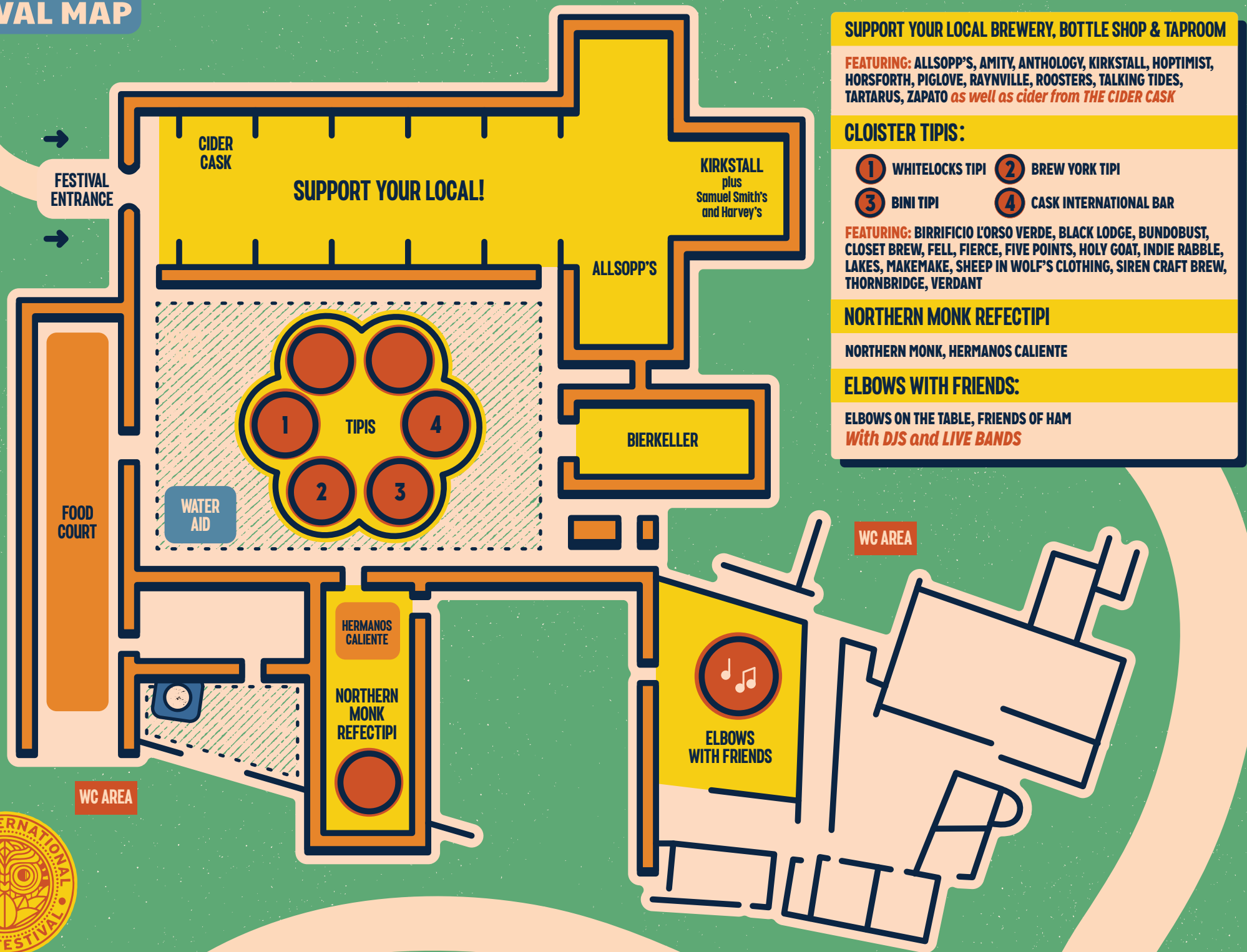
